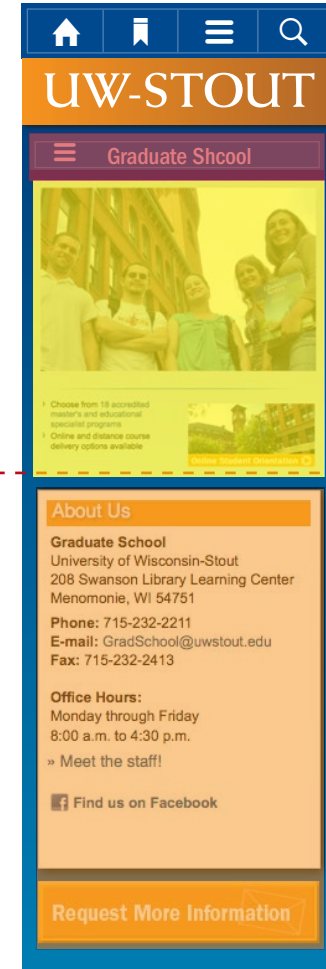

Current Financial Aid News:

Payment due dates for Spring 2014: February 9, March 11
On February 9th, 10% of your fall bill is due. If your fall financial aid covers your 10% amount due, you do not need to make a payment by February 9th. Your fall bill is due in full on March 11th. A 1.5% finance charge will be applied monthly to any remaining balance due after March 11th.

Do you need additional financial aid to cover your bill?
You will find information and application instructions for additional loans (the Parent PLUS Loan, SELF Loan, and alternative education loans) on our Loans webpage.

Financial aid for WinTerm:
If you are taking a WinTerm course and are interested in using financial aid, you must submit the online WinTerm Financial Aid Application. You must be registered for WinTerm before submitting the application.

Submitting IRS tax information to UW-Stout:
If you received a Verification Worksheet in the mail from our office, visit our Submit Verification & Tax Information webpage to view instructions on submitting your IRS tax information to our office.

Be aware of limits to financial aid eligibility!
Schools are required to review your academic progress (your cumulative GPA and the rate at which you are completing your classes). There are also maximum lifetime (aggregate) limits to how much Pell Grant and Stafford Loan you can receive, and a limit to the number of credits for which you are eligible for aid. You must be aware of the limits to financial aid eligibility.

Future Students: Get an estimate of your future costs and financial aid:
The Net Price Calculator provides an estimate of your costs and financial aid for an academic year at UW-Stout. The estimated costs you'll see include both actual billed charges and expenses you may have beyond your billed charges (such as transportation and miscellaneous living expenses).
